The project is located within the Rural Reserve (RRv) zoning/comprehensive plan designated area as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps adopted July 5, 2016, and as thereafter amended. A letter of completeness was not issued, and the application was determined to be complete on May 16, 2023.

No other governmental permits are required for this specific proposal from Skagit County Planning and Development Services, however, other approvals are required for stormwater review.

A public hearing before the Skagit County Hearing Examiner is not required for this project.
