NOTICE OF DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION AND SEPA COMMENT PERIOD**

Notice is hereby given that on April 7, 2023, Rick Clark filed an independent State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) checklist (#PL23-0169) for creation of a “Critter Pad” to provide an area for livestock to congregate during times of heavy rains and saturated soils during the winter months. The applicant intends to elevate an approximate 1 – 1 ½ acre area by approximately 4 – 5 feet on a portion of a 20-acre parcel. The project anticipates the placement of approximately 5,000 cubic yards of material. The proposed project is located within the Rural Reserve (RRv) zoning/comprehensive plan designated areas as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps adopted July 5, 2016, and as thereafter amended. A letter of completeness was not issued, and the application was determined to be complete for review purposes on May 2, 2023.

The site is located at 36569 State Route 20, Sedro-Woolley, within a portion of Section 18, Township 35N, Range 7E W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington. (P43014).

A completed Environmental Checklist, site plan, and other application materials are on file with Skagit County Planning and Development Services. This information is available to the public on request. Other governmental approvals or permits that may be required for this proposal from Skagit County Planning and Development Services include: Approved Grading Permit (submitted under file #BP23-0275).

A decision on the application will be made within 120 days of the date the application was determined complete, which was 5-2-23. A public hearing before the Skagit County Hearing Examiner is not required for this project. Any person desiring to express his or her views or to be notified of the action taken on this application should notify Brandon Black **in writing** of his or her interest within Fifteen (15) days of the date of publication of this notice which is 5-4-23. Failure to respond within the comment period could result in loss of the right to appeal. The file can be viewed at Planning and Development Services which is located at the Continental Place address listed below.

Written comments must be received no later than 4:30 pm on: **May 19, 2023.**

Email correspondence **will not be accepted**, however, comments may be submitted via the PDS website under the “recent legal notices” tab. (www.skagitcounty.net/pdscomments)

The Lead Agency expects to issue a DNS for this proposal and the Optional DNS process is being used (WAC 197-11-355). **This may be the only opportunity to comment on the environmental impacts of the proposal.**
