Notice is hereby given that on June 13, 2024, the Hearing Examiner approved Special Use Permit PL20-0507 and Forest Practice Application PL22-0435 to allow for the expansion of an existing 10 acre gravel mine to include an additional 30 acres in three phases.

The proposed project is located within a portion of the property described as parcel numbers P44865 and P123394, approximately six miles east of Concrete along State Route 20.

The full application for this proposal is on file with PDS and was reviewed under the provisions of Skagit County Code (SCC). This information is available to the public on request.

The applicant and/or party of record may appeal this decision to the Skagit County Hearing Examiner following the procedures of SCC 14.06.110(7) through 14.06.110(14). Parties with standing to appeal must submit the Notice of Appeal application and appeal fees to Planning and Development Services within 14 calendar days of the publication of this Notice pursuant to SCC 14.06.110.
