Twin Bridges Marina

Maintenance Dredging of the marina boat basin  
and the approach area along the Swinomish Channel

**Project Description:** Twin Bridges Marina, LLC filed a Shoreline Exemption application PL24-0042 for the maintenance dredging of the marina boat basin and associated approach area along the Swinomish Channel. The dredging action would be limited to re-establishing the originally permitted basin and channel depths using mechanical dredging methods. Approximately 31,284 cubic yards of material would be removed to a range of -10 to -12 feet MLLW depth. The dredging equipment would consist of a crane with a clamshell bucket on a barge and a transport barge to dispose of the dredged material at the Dredged Material Management Program Rosario Strait Dispersive Disposal Site managed cooperatively by the Washington State Department of Natural Resources, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency – Region 10 and the Washington State Department of Ecology.
