**AFFECTED WASHINGTON STATE LAWS**

The Shoreline Management Act (RCW 90.58), being a law covering widespread geographical and jurisdictional areas and entities, is, to some unquantifiable degree, affected by and affects a number of other Washington State laws. This is not to say, however, that there is conflict between the Shoreline Act and other laws or that one takes precedence over another. Rather, the following laws are listed for reference purposes for the benefit of the program user, the applicant, and the general public.

This appendix will, no doubt, be modified and refined as the Master Program is put to use as appropriate and required. This list is by no means complete.
