3. Public Hearing: 2012 Comprehensive Plan Amendments

Staff will introduce the <u>2012 Comprehensive Plan Amendments</u>. Following the presentation, the Planning Commission will ask for public testimony on each proposal in the order listed, and people can provide three minutes of comment on each. Public testimony may be used to highlight the key elements of written comments that provide additional detail. - C-1. Proposal to amend Skagit County Comprehensive Plan to incorporate by reference the 2012 Skagit County Parks and Recreation Comprehensive Plan.
- C-2. Proposal to re-designate and rezone P118792, an approximately .3 acre parcel owned by Del Mar Community Service on which are located two water tanks, from Rural Resource-NRL (RRc-NRL) to Rural Reserve (RRv).
- C-3. Proposal to re-designate and rezone 4 parcels (P74450, P103560, P103559, P74451), 1.5 acres in size located north and west of La Conner, to Rural Business (RB).
- C-4. <u>Proposal to amend the Bayview Ridge Subarea Plan</u>.

4. Deliberations: Capital Facilities Plan Update

The Planning Commission held a public hearing on the <u>Capital Facilities Plan Update</u> on October 15, 2013. Written comments were accepted until October 24, 2013 at 4:30 pm. The Planning Commission should review the proposal, public comments, and supplemental staff report (available on the <u>CFP website</u>) and plan to deliberate on the proposal and issue a recommendation.
