Approval of Minutes (3/22/2022)

New Planning Commissioner Introduction

Chair Raschko introduced the newly appointed Planning Commissioner for District 3, Jennifer Hutchison. Commissioner Hutchison introduced herself and provided some detail on her background.

Work Session: Stormwater Code Update

Andy Wargo, Skagit County PDS staff, provided a presentation on the proposed stormwater code amendments. Skagit County staff provided a matrix to the Planning Commission to compare the proposed stormwater code amendments with the current code language. Andy Wargo specifically went over how the code amendments will affect permit review requirements and stormwater thresholds.

Director's Update

Director Hal Hart updated the Planning Commission on reduced permit processing times and the new permit software. Director Hart then discussed the new projects near the Port of Skagit including new hangars, road and utility work, and business expansions. The Planning & Development Services Department is wrapping up the Shoreline Master Program approvals and will begin work on the Comprehensive Plan update later this year.
