#### **Approval of Minutes**

Chair Raschko asked for a motion to approve the April 8, 2025, minutes.

#### **2025 Periodic Comprehensive Plan Update Deliberations**

Chair Raschko opened deliberations to continue developing recommendations and findings of fact on the 2025 Periodic Comprehensive Plan update from the April 8<sup>th</sup> meeting. This included the Capital Facilities Element, Economic Development Element, Climate and Resiliency Element, Implementation Element, and the City of Anacortes UGA expansion request. Commissioners made their proposed recommendations which were tracked in the draft recorded motion document. The Planning Commission also added to the findings of fact and reasons for recommendation that were suggested by staff.

Chair Raschko asked if there was a motion to approve the recorded motion regarding the 2025 Periodic Comprehensive Plan update.

Vice Commissioner Candler moved to approve the recorded motion.

Commissioner Hughes seconded.

Vote: Support- 8, Oppose- 0, Abstain- 0, Absent- 1. The motion carried.

## **Department Updates**

Next week, April 22<sup>nd</sup>, there will be a work session for the Commission to review the proposed development regulations which include new regulations to implement comprehensive plan policies, a reorganization of the Unified Development Code, and updates to Critical Areas Ordinance. The Planning Commission will hold a Public Hearing on May 6<sup>th</sup> and deliberations on May 20<sup>th</sup>.

## **Planning Commissioner Comments and Announcements**

Planning Commissioners thanked those who participated, provided comments, and contributed to the process. Concerns were expressed by Commissioners about state legislative mandates that have created new Growth Management Act requirements. Planning Commissioners thanked staff, consultants, and the public for their work. The Commissioners shared that they appreciated working with each other and the respectful working relationship.
