Summary of Meeting

Roll Call

Vice Chair Candler began the meeting with a roll call.

Approval of Minutes (5/24/2022)

Vice Chair Candler introduced the minutes from the last meeting (5/24/2022) for approval. A motion to approve the May 24th meeting minutes was initiated by Commissioner Henley and was seconded by Commissioner Mitchell. There was no discussion and the minutes were approved unanimously.

Public Remarks

Vice Chair Candler opened the meeting for public comment on any issue before the Planning Commission. There were no public comments.

Deliberations: Stormwater Code Update

Jenn Rogers, Assistant Long Range Planner, reviewed the previous work sessions on the stormwater code update and the anticipated schedule for adoption of the new code language. Andy Wargo, Stormwater Review Technician, then reviewed the public comments received on the proposal and the staff response to each issue brought to the Planning Commission. Vice Chair Candler then opened deliberations on the stormwater code update proposal. Commissioner Hughes moved to adopt the Amendments to the Stormwater Management Standards, Skagit County Code 14.04, 14.18, 14.22, and 14.32. Commissioner Mitchell seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously, 6-0-3, with three commissioners being absent.

Director's Update

Director Hal Hart updated the Planning Commission on the Shoreline Master Program discussions with the Board of County Commissioners. The Board and staff are considering applications for grant funding to study sea level rise risks in Skagit County. Jenn Rogers then informed the Planning Commission that the Board of County Commissioners had voted to approve a docket for the 2022 Comprehensive Plan amendments and the included petitions would be introduced at the next Planning Commission meeting on June 28, 2022. Director Hart then discussed large projects in development in the County, including Lindell Yachts and Westland Whiskey.
