Planning Director Hal Hart discussed robust development occurring to the airport environs coming this summer and fall. Rural growth is happening in the form of infill development in Bay

View and Big Lake. Mr. Hart brought up the Agriculture Advisory Board and the agricultural tourism work that will be resumed after the SMP update is finished. Mr. Gill noted some key updates, including the next Planning Commission meeting on October 12<sup>th</sup>. Ongoing efforts include the SEPA determination on the 2021 Docket items, the Countywide Planning Policy 12.17 update, and the Capital Facilities Plan update.
