Approval of Minutes (11/8/2022)

Chair Raschko introduced the minutes from the last meeting (11/8/2022) for approval. A motion to approve the November 8th meeting minutes was initiated by Commissioner Henley and was seconded by Commissioner Mitchell. The minutes were approved unanimously.

Director's Update

Director Hal Hart gave a brief update on bills expected to be introduced during the 2023 state legislative session including those which did not pass in the last session but are expected to be brought back next year. Director Hart then discussed ongoing commercial projects in the County and the status of growth projections expected in early 2023. <u>Deliberations: Annual Capital Facilities Plan Update and Transportation Improvement Program</u> Long Range Planning Manager Sarah Ruether presented on the process for the annual update to the County's Capital Facilities Plan and highlighted some of the biggest changes. A draft recorded motion was then provided to the Planning Commission for review. Commissioner Mitchell initiated a motion to approve the Capital Facilities Plan as presented by staff. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Rose and there was no discussion. The motion passed unanimously, 8-0-1, with one commissioner absent.
