- The group reached voted and reached consensus on topic 3 (geography), and 5 (King County decision), with 2 (SVTF) pending discussion with Nicole, SVTF Executive Director, about the Department's recommendation to reduce the proposed window of operation from March 1- May 31 to March 15 May 15.
 - The approved proposals are <u>Voted CAG response to Remand Question #3:</u>
 Geography and <u>Voted CAG response to Remand Topic #5:</u>.
- The group recommended to sunset the proposal for binding arbitration and add in as a recommendation in the final package.
- CAG members asked about the AAB letter outlining their recommendations on these issues. County staff receive the letter on June 16; the County proposed that Matt Steinmann, AAB representative to the CAG, present the AAB recommendations to the CAG at the next meeting
