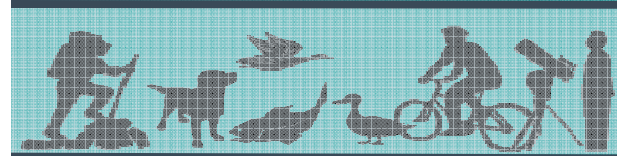

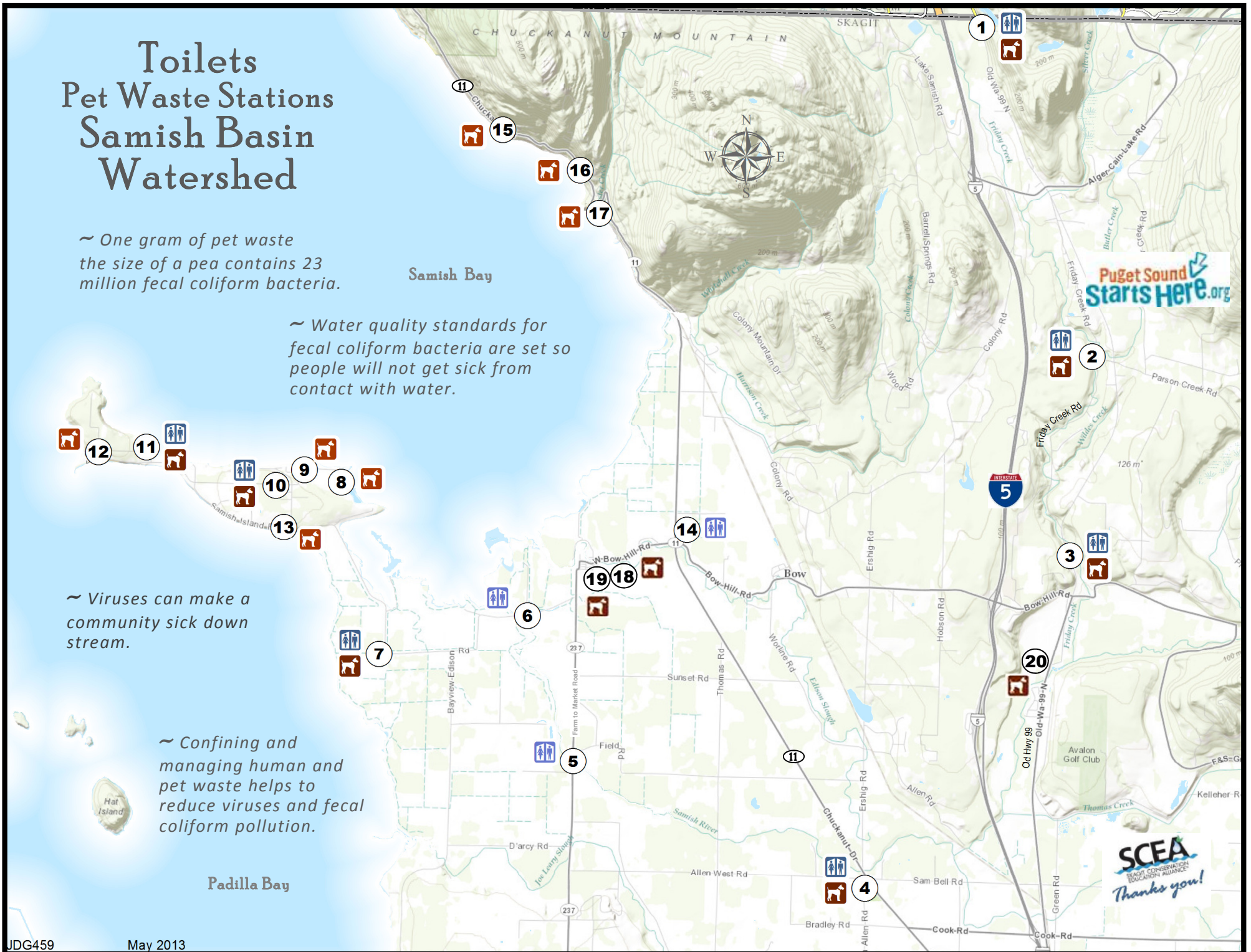
# Toilets Pet Waste Stations Samish Basin Watershed

~ One gram of pet waste  
the size of a pea contains 23  
million fecal coliform bacteria.

~ Water quality standards for  
fecal coliform bacteria are set so  
people will not get sick from  
contact with water.

~ Viruses can make a  
community sick down  
stream.

~ Confining and  
managing human and  
pet waste helps to  
reduce viruses and fecal
