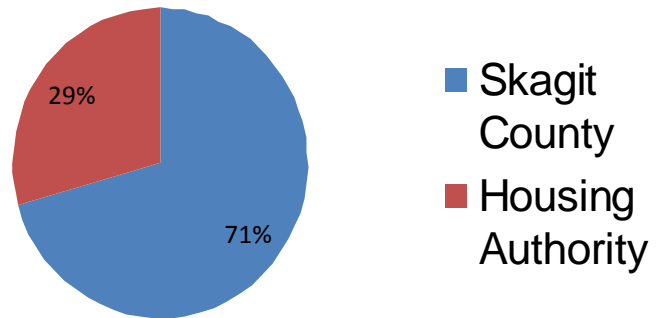
Lafayette Rd Improvement (Raspberry Ridge)



Project Funding:

Project costs are estimated between \$425,000 and \$495,000. Skagit County and Housing Authority of Skagit County will each be contributing to a portion of the costs.

Project Narrative:

The Lafayette Road Improvement Project is a partnership between Skagit County, City of Burlington and Housing Authority of Skagit County. The project begins at the intersection of Gardner Road and runs east on Lafayette Road approximately 1300 feet. Improvements will add a center turn lane and widen the existing travel lanes. Curbs, gutters and sidewalks will be added on both sides of the roadway, and a storm drainage system and City of Burlington sewer will be extended down the project area.
