### UPDATES

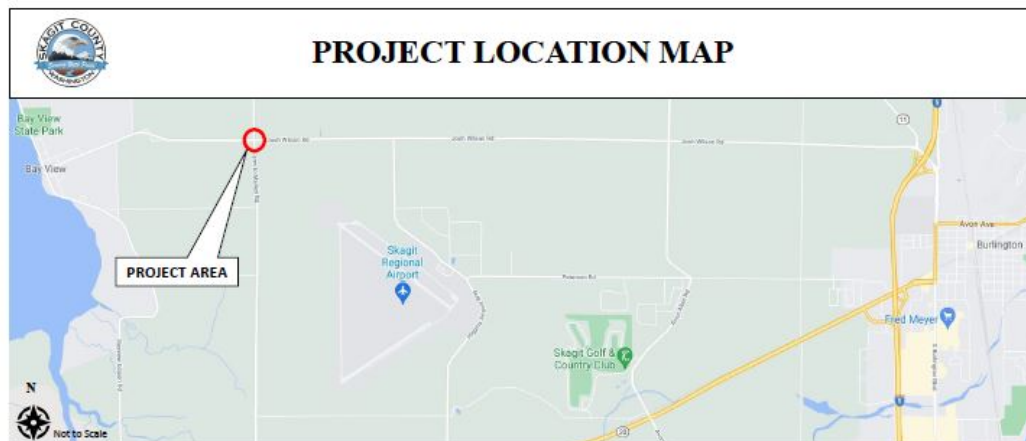
#### September 12<sup>th</sup>, 2022:

We are proud to announce the road is open and this project is now “Substantially Complete”.

Please know that though road is open, there is some remaining minor construction work to be done (related to availability/delay in procurement). Once we get these final parts, our contractor will be out to perform these final installations. There may be some minor disruptions to commuters with short-term shoulder closures.

#### Project Description

This project will convert an existing two-way stop-controlled intersection at Farm to Market Road and Josh Wilson Road meet into a single-lane roundabout. The work will include the construction of a central island, truck apron, concrete curb and gutter splitter islands, new stormwater culvert, new asphalt roadway surfacing, lane striping, new road signs, and the installation of an illumination system to light the intersection.



The Engineer’s estimated construction cost range is between \$1.5 and 1.8M

Bids were opened on July 19th, 2021.

Work was substantially completed on September 9<sup>th</sup>, 2022.
