Objectives of the 2023 Rate Study

- Reduce the road fund subsidy/contribution to the ferry operating deficit
 - Currently averaging \$1M/Year
 - Possibly cap road fund contribution (dollar amount or 65%/35%)
 - Forward thinking for financial planning (rather than 5-year look back)
- Simplify the fare structure for future electronic ticketing
 - o Eliminate user accounts & replace with punch cards for oversize/commercial
 - o Standardize discounts and expiration on multi-ride media
 - Eliminate unused categories
- Recommend fare policies for existing operations while planning for future ferry replacement
 - o Public wants e-ticketing; plan for that expenditure/staffing needs
 - o Thinking about the future ferry and routine battery replacement & realistic maintenance costs
- Use previous studies and stakeholder input to guide the process
 - Operations & Service Study, Jan. 2021
- Evaluate opportunities for ancillary revenue
 - o KPFF Subconsultant, T4 Media
 - On-site meeting 3/14 to discuss options for non-farebox revenue

2023 Budget

- Budget is ongoing process
 - July County Auditor written budget notification
 - August Preliminary budgets filed/submitted to BCC
 - November Preliminary budget available to public
 - December Public hearing to consider adoption
- Projections for 2023 based on YTD figures through June 30, 2023
 - o Will be updated this year during budget cycle
 - Budget cut by \$250K (\$200K of which will be deferring maintenance to 2024)
- 2024 Ferry Division Budget
 - No haul-out planned; catch-up on deferred maintenance
- Future Projects (Pending budget approval)
 - o Electronic Ticketing
 - o Parking Lot Improvements



2023 Revenue Target Report

- New fare policy resolution (rescinding previous resolutions)
- Timing report due to County Road Administration Board April 30
- Final audited expenditures & revenue available end of March
 - Report is typically drafted when available
- Board decisions
 - o Revenue Target
 - o Use of different sources of revenue



2022 Revenue Target

\$1,463,031

- Resolution R20110382, Attachment "B"
 o Amends R20100050
- Evaluation period 2017 through 2021
- 5-year average (look-back)
- 65% fare recovery requirement
- Capital expenditures are not included
- Farebox revenue has not met the revenue target since 2018



For Board Consideration

- Public Comment
 - o Staff is compiling to share with the Board
- Recommendations for future methodology
- Multi-ride passes
 - o Lower number of tickets on a pass and shorten the expiration date
- Oversize vehicles
 - Reduce the level of fare increase as length increases
 - o Include pricing for trailers
- Capital Surcharge
 - o Alternative pricing comparative to what other system operators are doing?
