Guemes Ferry Weekend Update

Car Ferry to Return Monday, May 18th

The pier-side maintenance work on the car ferry will be completed on schedule this weekend. The ferry will return to service at **6:30 am on Monday, May 18**, operating on the normal non-peak schedule. A summary of the completed work items will be included in next week's May newsletter.

Peak Season Begins May 20 – Peak Tickets Now Available for Purchase

As a reminder, peak season starts next Wednesday, May 20. Nonpeak tickets cannot be used from May 20 through September 30. Peak season tickets are now available to purchase, along with nonpeak tickets, on our website, mobile app, and the Anacortes terminal ticket kiosk. All tickets purchased in 2026 will expire after December 31, 2026.

Updated 2026 Fare Schedule

The County Commissioners adopted the 2026 fare schedule via [Resolution #R20250259](#), which went into effect on January 1, 2026. The Commissioners and staff identified an error in the oversized vehicles calculations during the adoption process. A public hearing was held on Monday, April 20th, to consider comments on an updated fare schedule correcting the error.

The Commissioners adopted the adjusted fare schedule via [Resolution #R20260089](#) on Monday, April 27th. The adjusted 2026 schedule can be found on the ferry website, www.skagitcounty.net/ferry. The new rates are effective May 20, 2026.

Memorial Day Sailing Schedule
