Ferry Service Alert for Tuesday, August 25

On Tuesday, August 25, a contractor will be on board performing ultrasonic testing on the vessel's superstructure. This is a non-destructive method used to check the thickness of metal on the vessel so we can plan maintenance for the 2027 shipyard period. To allow this work to happen safely, the inside lane of the car deck will be closed all day. In addition, there will be no 2nd 11:15 a.m. sailing that day. All other loading and unloading operations will continue as normal. Thank you for your patience while we complete this important work to continue preserving our 47-year-old ferry.
