Project Description

Restoration and fencing work occurred along 1,110 linear feet of Thunder Creek. A total of 278 feet of fencing was installed. This was a unique case in that the landowner requested a fence-type outside the allowable budget for this project. The Natural Resource Stewardship Program purchased the juniper poles while the landowner dug the holes for them and purchased the cross-fencing. Skagit Fisheries then installed the fence, allowing the landowner to receive the type of fencing they desired for their horses while working within the allowable budget for the project. The project included 275 native plants in 0.25 acres. This also included the removal of English Ivy and some Himalayan blackberry. This project will be in on-going maintenance until 2013.
