PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project consists of designing a 20,000 sf behavioral health facility providing 16 crisis stabilization beds as well as 32 co-occurring treatment and acute detox beds. New facility will be constructed on County-owned property in Sedro-Woolley, WA. This project has Department of Commerce funding requiring LEED silver standards. Timeline should start construction no later than spring of 2024.

The work to be performed by the selected consultant will consist of, but not be limited to design of the project; essential public facility approval; preparation of project plans and specifications in compliance with local, state, and federal requirements; construction cost estimate; permitting; Department of Health construction review; LEED certification; and construction management.

SUBMITTAL

Cover letter shall include the following information: Firm name, phone number, and email address; Name of Principal-in-Charge, Project Manager, and Key Personnel. The submittal package shall be limited to one page cover letter and a maximum of eleven (11) letter size pages of qualifications.

Submittals will be evaluated and ranked based on the following criteria:

1) Key personnel; 2) Firm's experience with behavioral health facility standards, specifications, and requirements; 3) Experience completing local essential public facilities approval process; 4) Experience with LEED standard projects; 5) Ability to meet schedule with anticipated completion in 2025; 6) Familiarity with relevant codes and standards; 7) Past performance/references. Selection will be made on qualifications submitted. Highest ranking firms will be interviewed.
