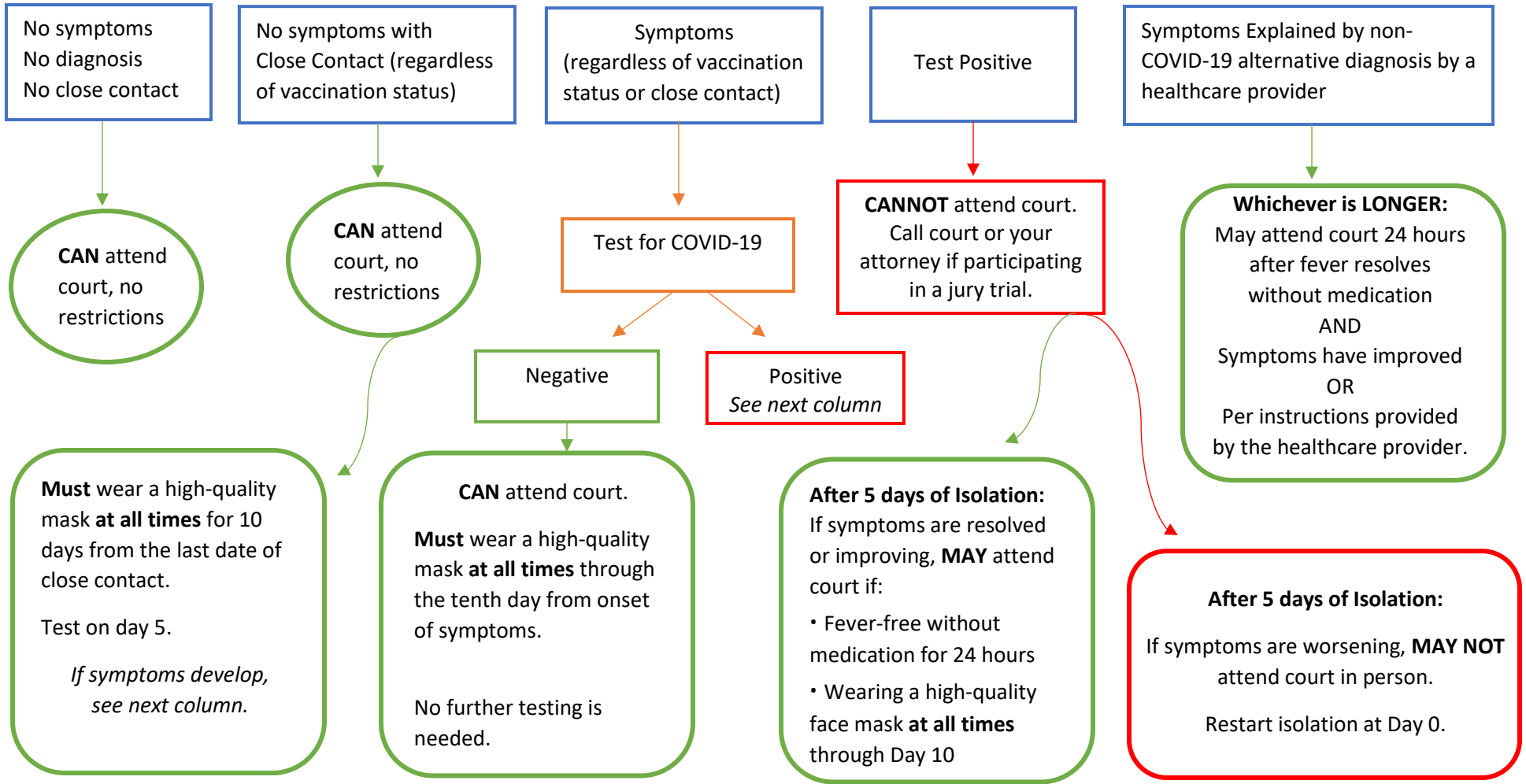


Skagit County Superior Court COVID-19 Screening and Illness Flowchart (12/30/22)

Definitions	Symptoms

No symptoms
No diagnosis
No close contact

CAN attend court, no restrictions

Must wear a high-quality mask **at all times** for 10 days from the last date of close contact.
Test on day 5.
If symptoms develop, see next column.

No symptoms with
Close Contact (regardless
of vaccination status)

CAN attend court, no restrictions

CAN attend court.
Must wear a high-quality mask **at all times** through the tenth day from onset of symptoms.
No further testing is needed.

Symptoms
(regardless of vaccination
status or close contact)

Test for COVID-19

Negative

Test Positive

CANNOT attend court.
Call court or your attorney if participating in a jury trial.

After 5 days of Isolation:
If symptoms are resolved or improving, **MAY** attend court if:
• Fever-free without medication for 24 hours
• Wearing a high-quality face mask **at all times** through Day 10

Symptoms Explained by non-COVID-19 alternative diagnosis by a healthcare provider

Whichever is LONGER:
May attend court 24 hours after fever resolves without medication
AND
Symptoms have improved
OR
Per instructions provided by the healthcare provider.

After 5 days of Isolation:
If symptoms are worsening, **MAY NOT** attend court in person.
Restart isolation at Day 0.
