- **Orientation and background** education from county staff representing departments such as Planning and Emergency Management on:
 - Comprehensive Plan climate component.
 - Hazard mitigation planning and current county practices.
 - How the Commissioners intend to use the committee's work (capital investment focus, boundaries of authority).
- **Education and overview from local experts** on:
 - Skagit floodplain and floodway, starting with Sedro-Woolley and west.
 - Diking and drainage infrastructure and how it functions.
- **Field Trip** to see marine dikes, river levees, drainage infrastructure.
- **Additional Study Sessions** on:
 - Coastal flooding.
 - River hydrology.
 - Hydraulic modeling.
